

Olin College of Engineering NACElink Privacy, Confidentiality, and Terms of Use

Students and Alumni:

This website is ONLY for current Olin College of Engineering Undergraduates and alumni of these programs. Students are expressly prohibited from sharing their accounts with anyone. It is the responsibility of students to ensure that their profile information is accurate.

Students are also responsible for keeping the interview appointments they make with employers and following through on commitments. Students who violate the terms of service or otherwise behave, in writing or in person, in a manner which jeopardizes Olin's reputation with employers, may lose NACElink privileges.

By using the Olin College of Engineering NACElink service, you consent to the storage of your resume and certain profile data on servers provided by the NACElink Network – owned and operated by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). Certain data you provide as part of your NACElink profile may also be used in aggregate reports for internal institutional purposes at Olin College. By uploading your resume to NACElink and granting permission for prospective employers to view it (within your privacy settings), you consent to the release of your resume and certain employment-related information of a personal and professional nature.
