Fundit.Olin.edu is hosted by ScaleFunder and is the only college-approved crowdfunding site at Olin. ScaleFunder is a fundraising platform for educational institutions allowing higher educational institutions to harness financial support. The main difference in ScaleFunder and other crowdfunding sites is that as soon as a donation is made for a project, the donor's credit card is processed and the funds are received in Olin's bank account. There is no waiting to see if the goal is funded or not and there is no fee.
