

## **Course Waiver Approval**

## **Obtaining A Course Waiver**

Students with proficiency in a given academic area may challenge a requirement in that area. A course waiver does not provide credit for a given requirement; rather, it exempts the student from completing that requirement. A sufficient number of credits in the academic area must be taken in place of the requirement. For example, waiving the Arts, Humanities, Social Science (AHS) Foundation requirement will require the student to take 4 credits of AHS in lieu of the foundation. Notation of all waivers will be placed on the student's degree audit as outlined by the faculty below.
