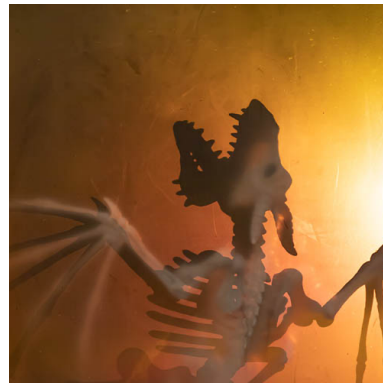
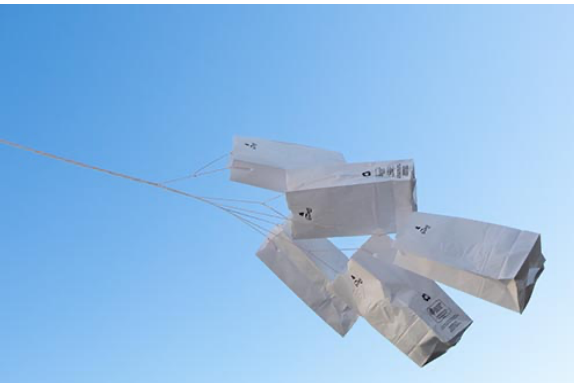


Digital Photography: Seeing is Believing
