



## Update from the Office of Post Graduate Planning

Seventy six seniors make up the Class of 2013. Below are highlights of their plans as of June 17<sup>th</sup>.

### Scholarships, Fellowships and Awards

- One student has been awarded the **Gates-Cambridge Scholarship** and will get a Master's degree in European Literature and Culture at the University of Cambridge in England. This same student was also a finalist for the **Rhodes, Fulbright, and Mitchell** scholarships.
- Twenty four of our seniors have been named **Grand Challenge Scholars by the National Academy of Engineers**. This combined curricular and extra-curricular program prepares students to be the generation that solves the grand challenges facing society in this century. This number is up from 3 Grand Challenge Scholars last May.
- One student has won the **Samsung scholarship**, and will pursue a Ph.D. in Computer Science at Carnegie Mellon University.
- Three of our seniors have earned **Sustainability Certificates** from combined course and project work at Olin, Babson and Wellesley. This program seeks to educate students to make use of the skills, tools and concepts learned at the three schools to address environmental challenges. The goal is to motivate individuals and society to more sustainable practices.

### Employment

- 76% (58 members) of the Class of 2013 have accepted offers of employment, including seven internships.
  - The average reported salary is \$83,791 — up from last year's average of \$80,964. This figure excludes seniors who plan to do internships or temporary assignments.
- Two seniors will be working on their own businesses after leaving Olin.
- **Microsoft** has hired 14 seniors again this year.
