Class of 2015

Eighty two (82) seniors make up the tenth graduating class of Olin College. Below are highlights of their plans as of May 13th.

Scholarships, Fellowships and Awards

- 2015 marks the first year that an Olin student received the prestigious **Marshall Scholarship**. No more than 40 Marshalls are awarded each year, and the winner may study in the field of his/her choice at the graduate level in the UK. Our graduate will pursue 2 one-year MPhil degrees in Physics at the University of Cambridge in England. This same senior also won the **Goldwater Scholarship** in his junior year at Olin, which provided \$7500 per year toward his undergraduate education.
- Nine of our seniors have been named **Grand Challenge Scholars by the National Academy of Engineering**. This program prepares students to be the generation that solves the grand challenges facing society in this century.
- Four of our seniors have earned **Sustainability Certificates** from combined course and project work at Olin, Babson and Wellesley. This program seeks to educate students to use the skills, tools and concepts learned at the three schools to address environmental challenges and to motivate society to pursue more sustainable practices.

Employment – Class of 2015 (continued)

- Olin start-ups and SCOPE employers are a big part of the story for this class:
 - Five seniors will go to work for Olin start-ups, earning competitive salaries - **Indico (3), Ivani (1) and Technical Machine (1)** .
 - Seven of these seniors were hired from a company that sponsored a SCOPE team this year, and again two of those were Olin startups. SCOPE sponsors that hired seniors were – **Locus Robotics (3), Ivani (2, including one intern), Boston Scientific (1), and Raytheon (1)**.
 - **Olin Start-up Indico** was one of the top employers of this year’s class with 3 hires.

One more interesting note:

- 95% of this class had at least one technical internship or research experience during their time at Olin.
- 80% had two or more technical experiences during their undergraduate education.
