Update from the Office of Post-Graduate Planning

The Class of '16 has done well! Seventy eight (78) seniors will receive diplomas as the eleventh graduating class of Olin College. Below are highlights of their plans as of May 11th.

Scholarships, Fellowships and Awards

- This year we had two **Fulbright scholars** to Estonia and Finland – the award to Finland was declined in favor of using the student's NSF award to study at **Columbia University**.
- We also received four **National Science Foundation Graduate Fellowships** – 3 for seniors, and 1 for a Class of '14 alumna who is currently at **Stanford**. Of the three seniors, one will be getting her PhD in Applied Math and Atmospheric Science at **Columbia University**, and the other two will pursue PhD's in Technology and Social Behavior at **Northwestern University**.
- Three of our seniors have been named **Grand Challenge Scholars by the National Academy of Engineering**. This program prepares students to be the generation that solves the grand challenges facing society in this century.

Employment – Class of 2016

- 68% (53 members) of the Class of 2016 have accepted offers of employment, including ten internships. 23% (18) are at various stages of the job search process - considering offers, interviewing or just beginning their search.
 - **athenahealth** had five hires from this class, and **Blue Origin, Ivani, MarkForged** and **Microsoft** have each had three.
 - Two seniors were hired by their SCOPE team this year (**Ivani**).
- **33** members of the senior class have reported salary data, and the combined average is **\$83,700**. This data point will be updated at commencement, and again six months following graduation. This figure excludes seniors with internships.
- **98.7% of this class had at least one technical internship or research experience during their time at Olin.**
 - 87% had two or more technical experiences during that time.
