TO CHECK A BIKE OUT

- Download the Movatic App on your phone
- Enter network name: *Olin College Bike Share*
- Use app to check-out a bike
- Use app to check-in your bike
- Only works with your Olin email address

REMINDERS

- Check gears, brakes, and tire pressure before you go
- Wear a helmet
- Don't hit curbs and potholes head-on
- DO NOT FORCE THE KEY AND LOCK!



There are also bikes with lime green tape around the frame. These bikes have been donated by students and are also available to you. You do not need a PIN number to use these bikes

Where do they live?

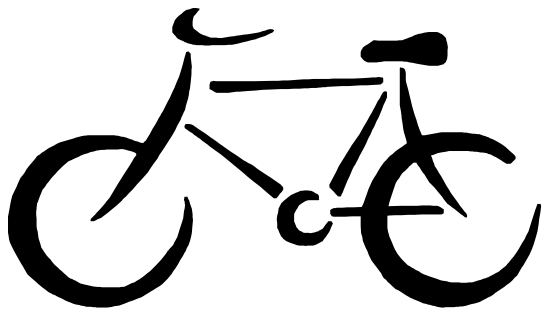
All GO bikes are in the GO bike racks in the lower level of East Hall in the bike room.

Bringing a bike to campus?

Question: I have a bike at home, should I buy a bike for at Olin?

Answer: Due to the limited room in the bike room, we ask that students use the GO bikes before deciding they need to bring a bike to school.

Question: I've got more questions about having a bike at Olin. Where do I go?

Question: I'm really into road racing, how do I register my bike?

Answer: Fill out a Bike Registration form, which can be found on the [Residence Life webpage](#). Submit completed forms to AJ Pave in East Hall 110, who will then provide you with a registration sticker. Bikes left in the bike room without registration stickers will be removed at the end of each semester.

Question: Where can I keep my bike?

Answer: There are spots in the East Hall Bike Room (located on the Lower Level) for bikes with indoor registration. Beyond that, there are bike racks outside. Some students also store their bike in their room.

You are not allowed to store your bike in hallways, stairwells, or common rooms as they can block pathways to the building exits in the event of an emergency. Bikes found in these places will be removed.
